It should prove to be an exciting opportunity to learn about a variety of engineering topics, make new or renew acquaintances and receive PDHs for biennium compliance!



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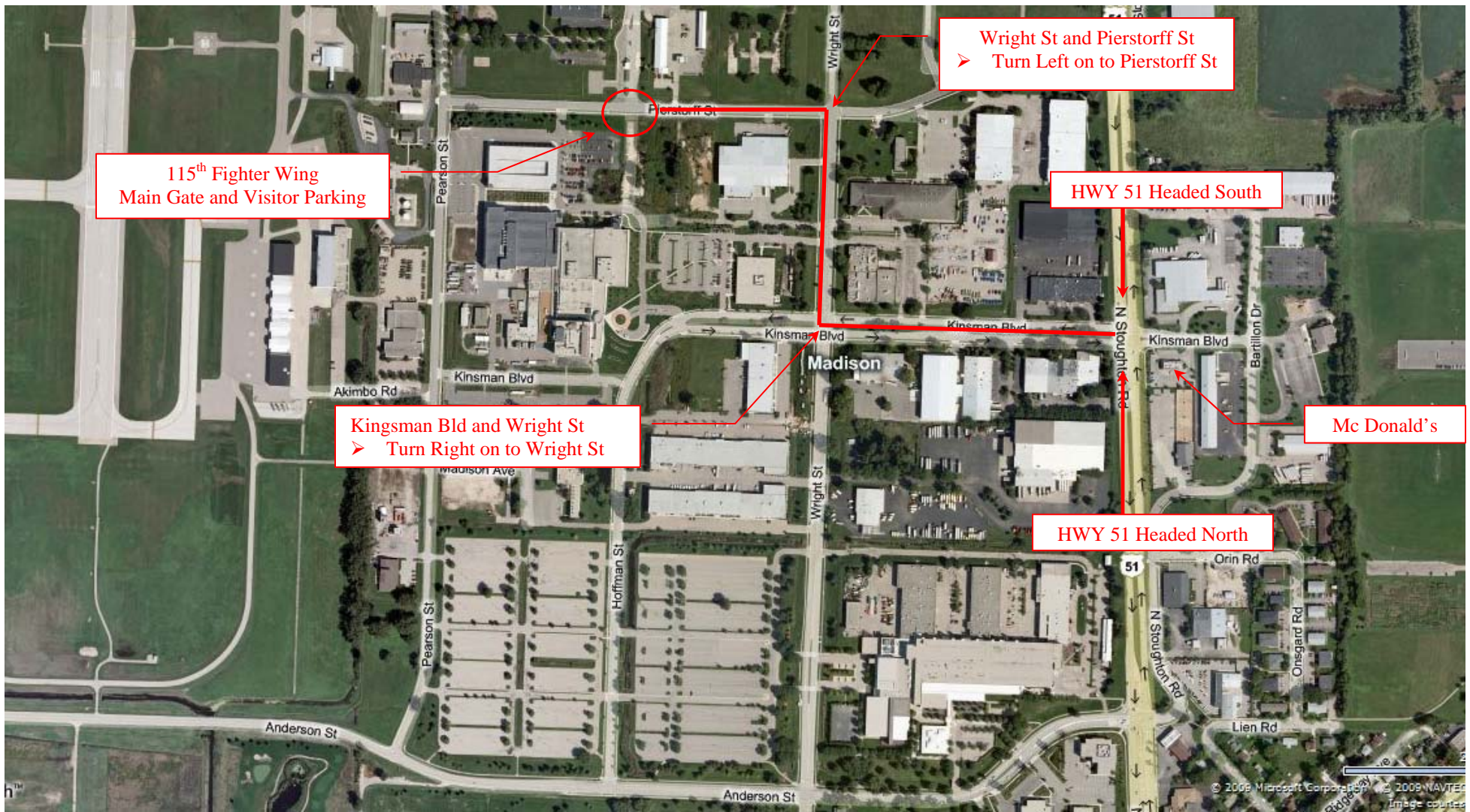
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Annual Golf Outing
